Thank you for your enquiry.

Please be informed that the project LIFE16 ENV IT 000442 - LIFE SAVE ended on 28/02/2023. As indicated in the public LIFE project database:

(<https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/life/publicWebsite/search>), the maximum EU contribution to the project is: 1,814,187 € over a total eligible cost of 3,156,832 €.

The project has received 70% of the above-mentioned EU contribution. This contribution has been provided as “pre-financing” according to our standard Grant Agreement. This pre-financing has been disbursed in two instalments, the first at the time of the signature of the Grant Agreement, the second in May 2020. The final report for the project was received on 22 Sept and is being analysed; when the evaluation is completed, a decision will be taken on the payment of the balance.

Dear Mr Ciccolella,

Thank you again for your enquiries with our colleagues at CINEA. Since normally all press requests go through the European Commission's press service, I am allowing myself to send you the replies to your questions, and please do not hesitate to continue to contact all of us in case you have any further queries.

As previously indicated, project activities ended on 28 February 2023.

The information included on the public dashboard (open/closed) concerns the administrative process and the execution of the final payment. After the payment process is finalised, the project will be tagged in the public dashboard as closed. It is therefore normal that the dashboard presently indicates this project as 'open'.

After the completion of the project, the coordinator had 90 days to submit the final report. In May 2023, the coordinator notified CINEA about a delay in the writing up of the report, and a grace period of 4 weeks was granted. Additional reminders were sent on 5 September and 19 September. The Final report was submitted on 22 September, but the submission was incomplete. Two further reminders were sent, and on 16 October 2023 the final report was re-submitted. However, there are still missing documents, which have been requested. The submission of these remaining documents is pending.

We have no knowledge of whether or not LIFE Mase contacted the beneficiary. We note that CINEA does not routinely transmit information to its LIFE national contact points about disbursement of funds to individual projects.

We see no reason to approach OLAF or any other competent authority with regard to the management of this project.

Concerning your fifth point, we will treat it as a request for access to documents under Regulation (EC) 1049/2001 and process it according to standard procedure.
